



- Be able to pass an Annual CORI Review and attend a one-time Protecting God's Children Program
- Attend approximately 5 meetings a year (in person)
- Be willing to prepare by praying, reading and reflecting for PPC Meetings
- Be willing to listen without judgement or decision, to the words and ideas from all parishioners
- Be a positive advocate for the parish and parishioners.
