(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC – BENEATH THE SURFACE By Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman

There are certain phrases that serve as a kind of shibboleth for millennials, a dog whistle that only ears formed between 1981 and 1996 can discern. "You can't sit with us!" is one of those phrases.


It's from the movie *Mean Girls*, (which, I hear from my younger family members, has now become cool with the kids again, so maybe my point about it being niche is incorrect). The character Regina George, merciless ruler of the cool kids, is rejected from the ultra-exclusive lunch table she herself formed when her minions, tired of her cruelty, serve her the most devastating words a teenager can hear in public: "You can't sit with us."

So passes earthly glory, as they say.

At first blush, this Gospel gives "Mean Girls" vibes. We have an image of the unlucky masses clamoring for entry into the kingdom of heaven as God locks the door against them, saying, "I do not know where you are from." Very "you-can't-sit-with-us."

But we need to remember that the people pounding on the door of heaven in today's Gospel aren't people who wanted a seat at God's lunch table — at least, not until it was the only lunch table left, because they had Regina George'd their way out of all the other ones.

Jesus' whole thing was that you can sit with us, whoever you are, wherever you're from and whatever you've done. But there are a lot of lunch tables in the world, and not everyone wants to be at one with rules like "repent" and "be good to that person you really don't like." It's not always an easy table to sit at, especially when there are so many other options.







TELL THE GOOD NEWS

Today's responsorial psalm tells us to "go out to all the world and tell the Good News." In their 1999 document on adult faith formation, Our Hearts Were Burning Within Us (https://bit.ly/OHWBWU), the United States Bishops, remind us that the "evangelizing spirit" is an "integral element of [our] baptismal calling, of the Church's nature and mission, and of a Catholic way of life."

So, how can we live out this calling? Here are a couple of simple ways, which might involve courage and risk...or at least a big breath before undertaking them. First, we can let other people, such as relatives and friends, know how being Catholic affects our daily lives. We can tell them, not in a preachy but

in a conversational kind of way, how knowing Jesus and belonging to a community of other believers has a positive impact on our thoughts and behaviors. We might even offer to pray with or for a person we know, or invite someone to Mass or to events sponsored by the Church. Second, we can get involved in a ministry in the parish or help out in another setting. Some examples are to become a Lector or Eucharistic Minister at Mass, join the choir, assist our young people by teaching in our faith formation program, volunteer with the Saint Vincent de Paul Society and help people in need, or give time or financial support to an organization that reaches-out to those less fortunate. These are all great ways we can live out our call to tell the Good News. Let's give it a try!




