Dei Verbum

The Dogmatic Constitution on Divine Revelation, or Dei Verbum (DV), is the sixth Second Vatican Council document we will be looking at in our Vatican II document series.

DV first talks about revelation in general, telling us that "Christ is both the mediator and the sum total of revelation." All there is to know about God is found in Christ, the one who helps us to know and experience God in our world. He is the mediator or bridge between us and the Father. Our knowledge of God, or divine revelation, is made up of tradition, Sacred Scripture and the Bible. This includes the lives/ teachings of the apostles, the unity of the Church and the Eucharist and the prayers.

The rest of *DV* addresses Sacred Scripture. Through the Old and New Testaments, scripture tells us of God's work of salvation among God's people, first among the Israelites (Old Testament) and then among Christians (New Testament). We are all encouraged to read, study, and pray over the Sacred Scriptures so that we may continue to grow in our understanding of God's presence and work in our world.
