It's CORI collection time <u>next</u> weekend, October 18&19. It is our parish policy, following Archdiocesan requirements, to

collect signed and completed CORI release forms from all of our employees and volunteers every fiscal year. If you are part of the leadership of a parish organization, belong to the St. Vincent de Paul Society or the finance or pastoral councils, coach one of our CYO basketball teams, teach religious education, volunteer as a pastoral visitor, or minister in some way at Mass, you are required to complete a CORI form this year.

We will have CORI forms available for you to complete and sign in the elevator lobby, in Sacred Heart Hall after all Masses next weekend. Please remember to bring your driver's license (or other form of government-issued ID), as you will need this to complete the form. You can also print and complete a copy of the form ahead of time and have your signature verified (with your ID) after Mass on the CORI collection dates.
